The policy is designed to ensure employees have a clear understanding of the policy related to business travel and expenses. Employees who do not comply with this policy may be subject to a delay or withholding of reimbursement.

#### **Business Meals**

A business meal expense will be reimbursed if it is deemed to be necessary and appropriate by a supervisor. When the meal is an essential part of a business meeting or activity, it will be reimbursed. In order to receive reimbursement for the meal, you have to submit the original receipt, including the provider's name and date and the purpose of the meeting. This information must be attached to the bill on a separate sheet of paper.

#### **Employee Morale**

Many expenses for employee morale activities can be reimbursed, including food and related expenses for social events, such as birthdays, holiday parties, and farewell parties, etc. Along with an explanation of the expense, a receipt must be submitted within thirty days of the purchase. If the receipt includes both personal and work-related expenses, remember to circle the work-related ones. The totals and explanation of the purchase should also be attached on a separate piece of paper. Most personal gifts are not allowable expenses; staff members must pay out of their pockets. The company, however, will reimburse the gift expense under certain circumstances, such as a family death or personal hospitalization.

#### **Telephone Calls**

Long distance phone charges for business purposes on a personal home phone or cellular phone can be reimbursed. A copy of the bill must be submitted along with an explanation of the purpose of the calls within thirty days.

#### **Conference/ Registration Fees**

Any approved conference registration fee can be reimbursed within thirty days.

Status Update:

To everyone reading this: SOS!!!



I've been graciously invited to give a talk at the Petronas Tower observation deck by the Department of Tourism. The topic of my talk is to be the obstacles and difficulties I've faced in my decade of living as an expatriate in this country. One purpose of my talk is to demonstrate to local people some of the challenges faced by outsiders living in their country. Another purpose of my talk is to be a sort of lead-in to the main point of the event, which is to introduce a new app aimed at foreign travelers. The app allows travelers to find essential services, including dining, accommodation, car rental, parking lots, and washing facilities while on the road. It comes equipped with GPS so that it can guide users to those things no matter where they are in the country.

Anyway, I don't really need to introduce the app; that will be the responsibility of the speaker after me, a government minister. So to be honest, the content of my talk will be pretty easy, since these are things that are simple for me to portray. But here's the catch: the talk needs to be entirely in Bahasa Malaysia, my second tongue. I'm pretty comfortable using it for daily affairs, but I've never given a formal talk like this using it. As a result, I'm extremely anxious right now. There are going to be at least a dozen video cameras on me, with thousands of people watching the talk as it is broadcast live on numerous networks. So finally that brings me to my question, and reason for posting here: Does anybody have any general tips for reducing anxiety before a speech?

Public speaking is an essential skill to develop, but it is also a common source of stress for everyone. Almost everyone is frightened when speaking in front of an audience. Many of us would try to avoid it but it is almost impossible. Whether we work alone or with a large number of people, we eventually have to speak in public. If you are one of those who are terrified of speaking in front of a group, there are many good ways to overcome a terror of delivering speeches.

Many professional speakers claim that by making many speeches, they get less nervous. In other words, practice is a good way of reducing speaker stress. Furthermore, there are local groups, such as Toastmasters, that help people to develop their public speaking skills. This kind of supportive place is the place where you can give speeches and you will be offered feedback at the same time. More importantly, you will be encouraged to make speeches by all the members of the group.

Besides places where you can gain support, there are other ways of minimizing your fears. Some speakers find it useful to picture audiences naked. This helps to reduce the intimidating factors coming from the audience. Some speakers practice speeches in front of a mirror. Many of them strongly advocate the importance of writing down and memorizing key points. Then it will not be easy to forget the content. Don't be intimidated now. Just go out and speak in public. It may take time, but the long-term rewards will be impressive.

公眾演說是一項重要的技能，但是對於大眾而言卻是常見的壓力來源。幾乎每個人都很恐懼在一群聽眾面前演說。大多數的人會選擇避免公眾演說可是這幾乎是不可能的。不論我們是獨自地或是和一群人一起工作，我們終究必須要進行公眾演說。如果你是其中一位害怕面對群眾說話的人，這有許多很好的方法可以去克服演說所帶來的恐懼。

許多專業的學者聲稱若有多次的演說經驗，就不那麼緊張了。換句話說，練習是減少演說者壓力的好方法。再者，有許多的當地團體組織可以協助人們增進演說技巧，就像是 Toastmasters 一樣。這樣支持性的團體就是一個你可以發表演說然後同時也會獲得回饋的地方。更重要的是你將會受到所有團體成員的鼓舞而持續發表演說。
