

If you have difficulty breathing or notice swelling in the throat area, discontinue this medication immediately. If you experience anything unusual, inform your doctor right away. If you experience an upset stomach while using this medication, take this product with meals.

Recently I have been suffering from mild angina and my doctor has prescribed Rivaroxaban to me for when it occurs. Usually when I experience angina, I feel a tightening in my chest, back, and shoulders. It is not extremely painful but quite uncomfortable, rather like indigestion, but my doctor has confirmed that it is indeed angina.

I am currently awaiting further tests, because angina is sometimes a symptom of a more serious heart disease, such as coronary microvascular disease. For the time being, I'm just praying it's not something more serious.

But here is my current situation: I have recently learned that I am 10 weeks pregnant. On the Rivaroxaban label, it clearly states, "Do not use this medicine if you are pregnant, breastfeeding, or have high blood pressure." It also says that the medicine could affect my child.

As the label advises, I have already stopped taking the medicine. So now I am wondering what kind of damage I could have already done to my unborn child. Does anybody know more specifically what kind of negative effects this medicine could have on the fetus? Also, are there any drugs for angina that are safe for pregnant mothers?

Of course I will ask all these questions to my doctor, but my next appointment isn't until next week.

Hi Basia,

I am a certified nurse and I am familiar with Rivaroxaban, the drug you were using. You were very smart in following the instructions on the label and stopping your use of Rivaroxaban once you found out that you were pregnant.

The truth is that this drug lacks sufficient data to say for sure whether you may or may not have done any harm to your child. Studies on animals have shown that in some cases, this drug can lead to premature births or fetal loss. However, there is no data at present showing that this is also the case with humans.

There's nothing you can do to reverse any potential harm at this point, so the best thing you can do is stay positive and be healthy at this point. Eat well, get lots of sleep, avoid drinking and smoking, and don't do any strenuous activity.

It sounds like you weren't using the drug much, just when you were experiencing angina symptoms, so you and your child should get through this fine. I would suggest that you try to see your doctor sooner, and hold out to that appointment without using Rivaroxaban or any other drugs. Your doctor will know what's best for you based on your medical history.

I hope this helps!
