

We just returned from our 2-week holiday in Guam 2 days ago, on which we had a one-night stopover in KL and stayed at the Classic Inn. The hotel came recommended to us by a friend, but I must say that we were entirely disappointed. We are an elderly couple, and found that the hotel was occupied mostly by young backpackers. At night, they stayed up well past midnight in the lobby sitting area, speaking loudly and drinking beer. We needed a good night of sleep before our long leg back to Wales, but we barely got a wink. The room itself was nothing special. The bed was lumpy, the pillows were stiff, and there were cobwebs on the ceiling. The water in the shower was lukewarm, and the hotel didn't even supply complimentary soap or shampoo. Maybe if you are looking for a party hotel then you would consider the Classic Inn, but for families or couples like us, I would strongly recommend thinking twice about staying here.

My wife and I are 65+, and we find the Classic Inn to be an ideal retreat from the busy streets of Kuala Lumpur, and it is ideal for people of any age. Indeed, there were some young people socializing in the lounge at night when we stayed before, but I noticed that the hotel staff made sure that they kept their voices down after the designated quiet time of 11pm, which is reasonable. If Joan Roosevelt happened to stay on

a night with a bad group of people, she shouldn't blame the hotel. We have stayed here many times over the years, and never had this problem. I think she was unlucky that night, but you can't really judge a hotel based on just one night's stay, especially when you have just been to Guam, where you probably stayed in a fancy resort.

Grand Trunk Park Designated as Off-Leash Area: A Grand Idea

In a city known for its lack of dog-friendly places for a stroll, the municipal government of Pittsburg's recent designation of the Grand Trunk Park as an off-leash area is great news for the

city's pet owners. All 612 acres of Pittsburg's 2nd largest park are now free for dog owners to let their furry friends run, catch Frisbees, and make new four-legged friends. Only one exception exists, which is of course the 18-hole Grand Trunk Golf Course.

This of course comes with a few regulations to keep the park safe and clean for the general public. Pet owners are 100% responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Waste bins are found throughout the park, and several of them will now include free bag dispensers for cleaning up doggie doo-doo. A maximum fine of \$1000 is in place for those who disregard this rule. Dogs should not be allowed more than 100 meters from their owners, and any dogs with a history of biting or panicking around other dogs should remain on leashes.

In a city with increasing numbers of dog owners, this is a true victory for the public.

NOTICE

This entire park is a designated off-leash area with the exception of the Grand Trunk Golf Course and summer swimming area.

Failure to pick up after your dog can result in a fine of up to \$1000.

Please stay within 100 meters of your dog.

Dogs with behavioral issues should still be kept on leashes.

In order to be a successful businessperson, you must build relationships with your clients. A good indicator of a successful relationship with your client is if you view them not as a client but as a human being. This will help you to understand their needs and decision-making processes.

My first tip for developing human relationships with clients is through small talk. I don't mean about the weather. Ask them about their family, their recent vacation, or their weekend plans. Be more personal.

Second, be there for them when they need you. Make yourself available and give them the impression that you are there to help them in any way and at whatever time that they need it.

Third, observe your client's reactions. If you are doing or saying something they like, they will tell you, perhaps indirectly through body language. On the contrary, if you aren't

Fourth, find ways to indentify with your client. It might be a shared personal interest or hobby, or a mutual professional goal. This will help to eliminate the client-client feeling of the relationship, and open the door to a friendlier, and mutually beneficial, relationship.

Comment:

Hi, Lisa!

I loved your article on top tips for doing business professionally. I think that by focusing on the human aspect of business relationships, you pave the way for a more ethical approach to business. If people see their clients as people and as friends, they will be less like to take advantage of or lie to them.

I have a few questions about your ponts, though, as follows:

- 1. In your second point, you indicated that one ought to make oneself available to clients whenever they need one. But I'm just wondering how this works in terms of one's personal privacy. I mean, I don't really want to encourage my staff members to feel that they need to work outside of their scheduled working hours or bend over backwards for their customers, answering their pesky phone calls at all hours of the day.
- 2. In the third point, you talked about clients' reactions such as body language. But since my staff members mostly do business over the phone, are there some other indicators they could pay attention to?

I know you must be busy, but I would highly appreciate if you could find a few minutes to reply because I am planning to summarize your points in an uncoming lecture I will be giving to a group of trainees in my company.

Reply:

- Hi, Jamie. Thank you so much for taking the time to read my article and I am glad you got something out of it. Your feedback is valuable and helps me to understand what my readers want. I would be happy to answer your questions.
- 1. I can certainly understand your point about working hours and not demanding that your staff members dedicate their entire lives to their jobs. We all need our personal time and companies must respect that. I think what I meant to say was that businesspeople must give the impression that they are easy to reach. Nobody can be available 24/7. Perhaps suggest that your staff members give their clients more than one contact method. For example, give clients an email address as well as a phone number. Have a friendly voice mail message that promises a call back at a specified time and date, and make sure to follow up on that. For email, if they won't a while, use the auto-reply feature to inform the customer. Nobody likes to wait for an unknown or unspecific amount of time.

2. Over the phone, one good indicator is the speaker's tone of voice. Another is long silences or sudden excuses to go.
I hope my answers have helped, and I am pleased to hear that you will be incorporating my points into your talk. I would only ask that you mention my name and please share my website address with your trainees.
